Report: Latest Update on Parish Council's Renovation of Heritage Road Signs

I. Introduction

There are two antique black and white road signs next to the highway within our Parish. The signs are sixty plus years old, have not been maintained and are in a poor condition. Residents have contacted the Parish Council requesting for the signs to be restored for future generations.

II. Actions

Email sent to Gary Overland (Highways NCC) requesting for the Parish Council to take responsibility for the maintenance and ownership of the signs – similar with the GPO phone box.

Response – Highways have no budget for these signs and if the Parish Council maintained them we would require public liability insurance, NSR qualification, permit to work and provide traffic management before working on the highway.

III. Actions

Further email sent to clarify, the request for the Parish Council to have ownership of the signs. The location of the signs do not impact the highway and are a similar distance to the highway as our Parish notice boards which the Parish Council maintains. Also noting the Parish Council does have public liability insurance.
