### **Review of Parish Council Policies and Procedures**

# **Summary:**

This report presents the results of the Working Group led by Cllr Baldwin to review and update Parish Council policies and procedures, in accordance with the National Association of Local Councils (NALC) recommendations. The goal of this initiative is to ensure that the Council's policies and procedures align with the specific needs of Langley with Hardley Parish Council, enhancing the Council's effectiveness and compliance with legal requirements. The revised documents aim to reduce the frequency of updates and provide clear guidelines for managing the Parish Council.

# **Background:**

Many of the Council's policies and procedures had not been reviewed since the pandemic, and some policies were out of date by up to 4 years. The working group review of Parish Council policies and procedures was undertaken to improve the efficiency and compliance of our Council with the guidance provided by NALC. The comprehensive review process incorporated past experiences and best practices from similar documentation.

- 2. **Data Protection Policy**: Ensuring the responsible handling of sensitive data.
- 3. **Equality and Diversity Policy**: Promoting inclusivity and equal opportunities.
- 4. **Policy on Record Management**: Addressing documentation control issues and presenting a plan for improvement.
